



PAS/GSK Pharmacist of the Year

Terms of Reference

The PAS/GSK PHARMACIST OF THE YEAR award is presented in recognition of a pharmacist (or pharmacists) who perform an outstanding single or long term service, as to bring credit and prestige to the profession of pharmacy.

1. The nominee must have made a special contribution to the profession of pharmacy either on a local, provincial or national level.
2. The nominee must be a member of the Pharmacists' Association of Saskatchewan (PAS) and a member in good standing of the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists.
3. The selection will be made by members of the PAS Awards Selection Committee.
4. When possible, the PAS/GSK PHARMACIST OF THE YEAR will be presented at the annual conference of the Pharmacists' Association of Saskatchewan.
5. The successful recipients will receive in the year the award is presented:
 - an engraved plaque or equivalent
 - complimentary conference registration
 - one night accommodation and travel expenses for the conference
 - 3 additional PAS Awards Banquet tickets
6. In the case where a group of pharmacists are nominated for a single contribution, only one award will be presented on behalf of the group.
7. The PAS/GSK PHARMACIST OF THE YEAR award does not necessarily have to be presented in any given year. If there are no qualified candidates nominated in a given year, the award will not be granted. Only one award may be granted in a given year.
8. Nominations are only valid for award consideration in the current year.

- Professional recognition (e.g., award from peers)
- Recognition by public (e.g., media announcements; recognition from patient)
- Publications (not necessarily research, may be provincial or national newspaper supplement, editorial or reporting in nature, public or professional; list examples within the last five years)
