

**Tenure-track faculty position – geriatrics and pharmacy practice**

The College of Pharmacy and Nutrition invites applications from qualified individuals for a full-time, tenure-track, faculty (Academic Programming) position focused on teaching and clinical practice, at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor in the Division of Pharmacy. The successful candidate will teach in the PharmD program, primarily in the area of geriatrics, and be required to establish and maintain a relevant clinical practice in a pharmacy setting, equivalent to approximately 20% of their time. The successful candidate will also be responsible for engaging in scholarly activities, supervision of undergraduate students, and relevant administrative activities.

The University of Saskatchewan's main campus is situated on Treaty 6 Territory and the Homeland of the Métis. The University of Saskatchewan is located in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, a city with a diverse and thriving economic base, a vibrant arts community and a full range of leisure opportunities. **Qualifications**

Candidates must possess a Bachelor's degree in pharmacy plus a master's degree or post-baccalaureate PharmD or equivalent. A PhD will also be considered but is not necessary to apply. To qualify, the candidate must be a licensed pharmacist in Canada, and either licensed or eligible for licensure in Saskatchewan by the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacy Professionals; Saskatchewan licensure must be obtained within 6 months of appointment date. We seek a candidate who has effective teaching, interpersonal, and communication skills. Preference will be given to candidates with previous teaching and clinical experience.

Salary bands for this position are as follows: Assistant Professor: \$93,293 to \$112,109; Associate Professor: \$112,109 to \$130,925. Pay will be commensurate on experience and rank. This position includes a comprehensive benefits package which includes a dental, health and extended vision care plan; pension plan, life insurance (compulsory and voluntary), academic long term disability, sick leave, travel insurance, death benefits, an employee assistance program, a professional expense allowance, and a flexible health and wellness spending program.
